What is this product?

Type

Société d'investissement à capital variable - Specialised Investment Fund

Term

This sub-fund has no maturity date. However, the board of directors may decide to close the sub-fund under certain circumstances.

Objectives

The sub-fund aims to generate long-term capital appreciation for its shareholders by investing directly in company shares (equities or equity-related securities) and in securities of issuers listed on regulated markets or depository receipts giving exposure to the above securities.

The fund may hold liquid assets on an ancillary basis.

Benchmark: The portfolio is actively managed on a discretionary basis without reference to a benchmark.

Intended investor

An investment in the Fund is only suitable for persons who qualify as Well-Informed Investors, (=any institutional investor, professional investor and any investor who meets the following:

- a) the Investor has confirmed in writing that he has the status of "Well-Informed Investor" and
- b) either the Investor invests a minimum of EUR 100,000 in the Fund (EUR 250.000,00 for Belgian residents)
- c) or the Investor has obtained an assessment made by a credit institution the meaning of Directive 2006/48/EC, by an investment firm within the meaning

of Directive 2004/39/EC, or by a management company within the meaning of Directive 2001/107/EC certifying such investor's expertise, experience and knowledge in adequately appraising an investment in the Fund.)

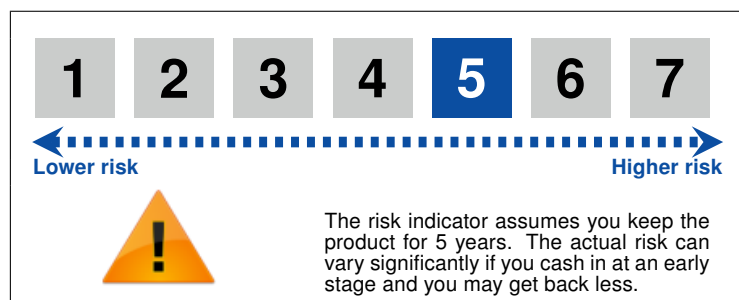
